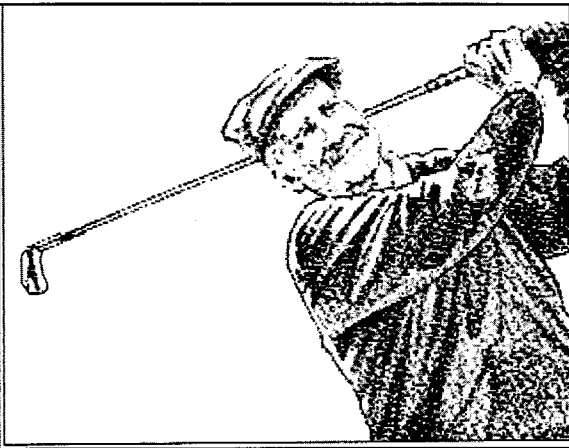

Friday, March 19th

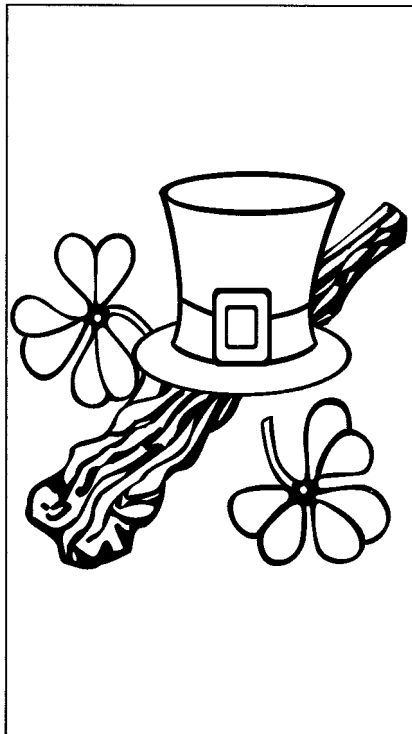

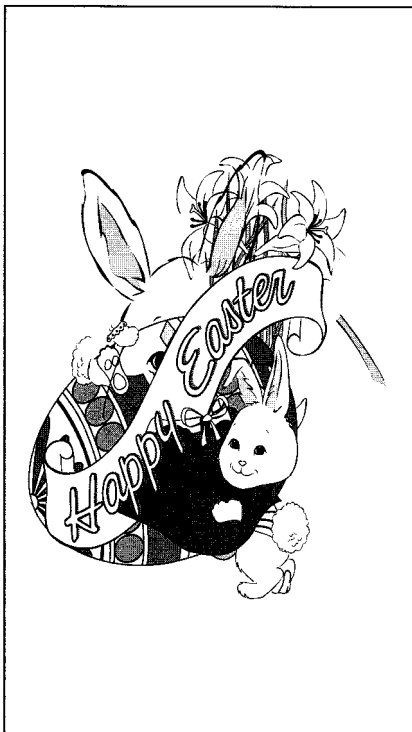

Hello everyone and welcome to March!

By this time I am sure we are all sick of winter and getting fired up to get back out on the links—I know I am! Hopefully, you all have made it through the coldest months and maybe even got to sneak away a bit to a warmer destination. With golf year 2010 approaching, I would like to talk briefly to you about a couple of items regarding this year. I believe these topics will be ones which you will find very positive for all.

First, we have decided to go ahead with another set of tees this year. This will allow for more and more opportunities for golfers to play at whatever distance and difficulty they are comfortable with. The new set of tees will be located between the current red tees and yellow tees. Obviously this will not make a huge difference on some of the holes, but many it will. Please allow a little bit of time for this transition to take effect because distances and ratings will need to be developed. With this change comes new colors for the tee blocks. To simplify this, the new order will go as follows from furthest away to closest:

- Back Tees (BLACK) (old blue)
- Next Tees Up (BLUE) (roughly old yellow)
- New Tees (YELLOW)
- Forward Tees (RED) (same)

I believe this will be most beneficial for everyone.

We have also changed tee-times. Don't worry, this will not be drastic, as we will still operate on the exact hour, every hour. The only difference will be times will alter 7-8 minutes. In other words, times will be as follows for every hour:

7:00 7:07 7:15 7:22 7:30 7:37 7:45 7:52 8:00

As you can see, we will still have the same number of tee-times each hour. However, this will eliminate the 11 minute gap we had at the end of each hour with hopes of spreading out play a little smoother.

The final subject I would like to touch on regards handicap posting. You are now allowed to post your scores on the internet. Just go to mngolf.org and set up an account and you will not have to stop in the proshop to post scores. Also, you must post scores in which you have played in the winter months. In the past, you could only post rounds which were played between April 15th – October 15th. So for those of you who play down south in the winter months, make sure you post those scores. Your handicap will now be updated year-round. Being able to post scores on the web will make this convenient for you.
